

RESOLUTION 2017-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ST. PETE BEACH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING COMMERCIAL NON-MOTORIZED WATERSPORT RENTAL USE IN AN EXISTING BUSINESS LOCATED AT 4211 GULF BOULEVARD; INCORPORATING THE CONDITIONS OUTLINED HEREIN AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission supports independently owned businesses within the City; and,

WHEREAS, the applicant desires to offer a recreational use to the residents and guest of the City; and,

WHEREAS, the application was heard by the Technical Review Committee on June 7th, 2017 and it was determined the outlined conditions appropriate to mitigate potential impacts imposed by the use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of St. Pete Beach, that:

Section One: The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

Section Two: The City Commission hereby incorporates the following conditions into the Conditional Use permit:

- 1) Customers renting non-motorized commercial watersports shall use the designated crosswalks when crossing Gulf Blvd, and
- 2) No launching of any non-motorized commercial watersports off the east side of the property into the water.


